### **Intro to CS Practice Python Quiz #2**

On paper, closed computer, notes, and books

In the space below, write a Python program that asks the user to enter a positive integer. Then, ask the user to enter a second positive integer, larger than the first. You may assume that the user will do as instructed and enter two positive integers, with the second being larger than the first.

After getting the two integers from the user, your program should use a **'for'** loop to display all of the integers in decreasing order from the second integer down to the first integer, inclusive. Each number should be displayed on a separate line.

Your code must be formatted properly (letter case, punctuation, indents, blank lines, etc.), but your program does NOT need to contain any comments. You may use global variables and, if you like, you may put all of your code into the main area of the program (that is, you do NOT need to use functions).
