### **Intro to CS Practice Python Quiz #3**

On paper, closed computer, notes, and books

In the space below, write a Python program that uses a while loop to get an unlimited number of lowercase words from the user. The words should be stored in a list, and the user will indicate that he/she is finished inputting words by pressing ENTER by itself. Then use any type of loop to display back to the user every word that contains the letter "e", one word per line, in the reverse order from which the user entered the words.

Your code must be formatted properly (letter case, punctuation, indents, blank lines, etc.), but your program does NOT need to contain any comments. You may use global variables and, if you like, you may put all of your code into the main area of the program (that is, you do NOT need to use functions). You may assume the user will enter all lowercase words containing only letters (no punctuation, numbers, or spaces).
